

Dance Education

Jane Franklin Dance, a professional modern dance company, addresses academics with movement, creativity and imagination.

In *After School Workshops* students engage in movement classes that encourage group participation, commitment and cooperation, and give a “team” experience to the creative learner. Workshops may be coordinated with faculty to meet academic needs, or with after school staff or parent-teacher organizations. Experienced dance educators bring materials to emphasize basic dance concepts, flexibility, coordination and strength.

After School Workshops of 8 sessions \$800

Arts Integration for Teacher's is an intensive session revealing how movement can enhance learning and provide a creative connection to curriculum. Fundamental dance elements and developmental movement theory provide a basis to encourage student self exploration and critical thinking. Teachers receive hands on practice in how movement can serve educational objectives and enhance student learning. Each Professional Development workshop can be crafted to specific subject areas.

Children's Workshop and Performance- School performances tie dance to the school curriculum in an enjoyable and educational way! Explore the tradition and history of Jazz music in *Jazz on Foot* or Science SOL's from simple machines to the states of matter in *Very Physical Science*. Our newest Children's performance invests in the language arts standards of learning to explore the power of words and movement through poetry. A workshop may precede or follow the performance giving children an opportunity to explore the on-stage materials through active participation in the classroom.

Arts Integration Residency- A residency includes classes during school hours, opportunity for teachers and artists to work together, experience and implement arts integration first hand and a creative process for students that culminates in a mini- performance. A team of professional dance educators inspire and engage students around a desired topic, from Science to Language Arts. Residencies can be crafted to suit the needs of each school, can be coordinated with faculty members, and can include core curriculum topics. Supplementary activities such as performances or Teacher intensives may be added.
