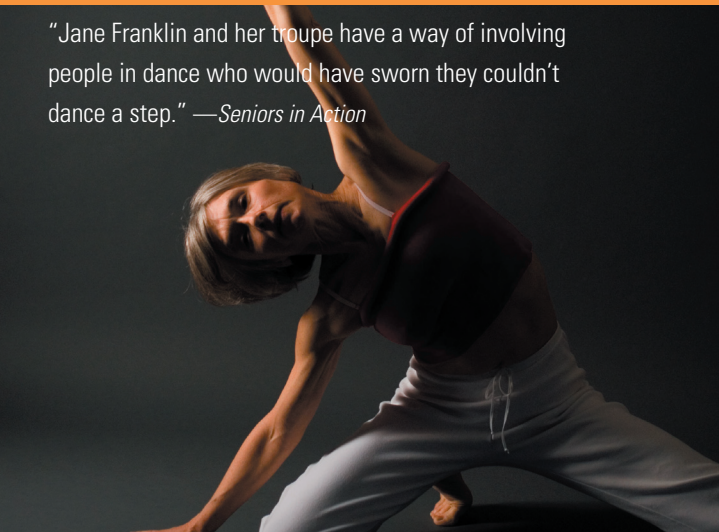


Connect

Adult Dance Technique is a delicious practice that assimilates and refines movement.



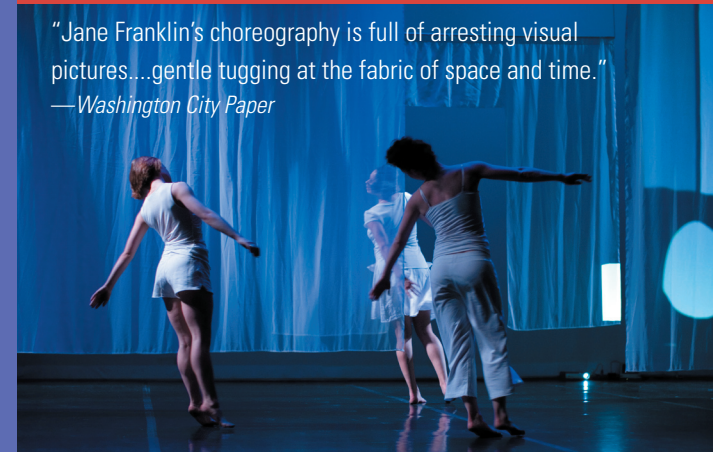

In partnership with music, multimedia and visual artists, Jane Franklin Dance crosses disciplines with wonder and surprise.

Recent repertory:

In Hiding uses fabric panels, shadow, and the human form. Layered projections alternately reveal and conceal the performers, becoming both a barrier and a passageway to presence.

Ring is a visually arresting piece incorporating a bamboo sphere, stands and hoops to evoke the Vietnamese countryside.

Found is a collaboration among musicians and choreographers that is unified by the suggestion of birds in flight.

Temporal Interference. New media elements create a moment to moment environment of sound and color.

Jane Franklin Dance brings "wit, vigor and flair" (*The Washington Post*) to the stage.

Jane Franklin's works draw attention to the movement, to the relationships between the performers, and to the connection between performer and audience.

The company offers:

- evening concerts, family matinee programming, community engagement projects for seniors, and dance education
- performances for theatrical settings, art galleries, outdoor spaces, or specific sites
- cross disciplinary dances with multimedia
- school performances
- works designed for specific communities or performance groups
