

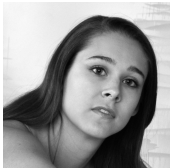
JANE FRANKLIN DANCE COMPANY MEMBERS

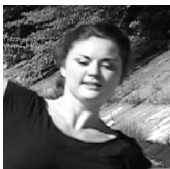
